Looking at Your nüvi

Power button: Press to turn the nüvi on and off.

Using the Main Menu



- **1** GPS satellite strength.
- **2** Touch to select a usage mode.
- **3** Current time. Touch to change time settings.
- **4** Battery status.
- **5** Touch to find a destination.
- **6** Touch to view the map.
- **7** Touch to adjust the volume.
- 8 Touch to use the tools, such as settings and Help.

Setting Up Your nüvi

Mounting Your nüvi

- 1. Remove the clear plastic from the suction cup. Place the suction cup on the windshield.
- 2. Flip the lever back toward the windshield.
- 3. Snap the cradle onto the suction cup arm.
- 4. Plug the vehicle power cable into the back of your nüvi.
- Plug the other end of the vehicle power cable into a power outlet in your vehicle. Your unit should turn on automatically if it is plugged in and the vehicle is running. Follow the on-screen instructions.
- 6. Fit the bottom of your nüvi into the cradle.
- 7. Tilt your nüvi back until it snaps into place.

WARNING: This product contains a lithium-ion battery. To prevent damage, remove the unit from the vehicle when exiting or store it out of direct sunlight.

Acquiring Satellites

- Go outdoors to an open area, away from tall buildings and trees.
- 2. Turn on your nüvi.

Acquiring satellite signals can take a few minutes. The bodd bars indicate satellite strength. When at least one of the bars is green, your nuvi has acquired satellite signals.

Using the Power Button

Press and quickly release the **Power** button to view additional options:

- Touch and to adjust the screen brightness.
- Touch Lock Screen to prevent accidental screen touches.
- Touch Power Off to turn off your nüvi. You can also turn off the nüvi by holding the Power button for 2 seconds.

Resetting Your nüvi

If your nüvi stops functioning, reset your nüvi by pressing and holding the **Power** button for 10 seconds.

Finding Points of Interest

- Touch Where To? > Points of Interest
- 2. Select a category and a subcategory, if necessary.
- 3. Select a destination, and touch **Go!**.
- 4. If necessary, touch **Start** to navigate the route.

To enter letters contained in the name, touch Where To? > Points of Interest > Spell Name.

To search for a location in a different area, touch Where To? > Near.

Following Your Route

Your route is marked with a magenta line. As you travel, your nüvi guides you to your destination with voice prompts, arrows on the map, and directions at the top of the map. If you depart from the original route, your nüvi recalculates the route.

Touch and drag the map to view a different area of the map.

A speed limit icon could appear as you travel on major roadways.



1 Touch to view the Next Turn page.

- 2 Touch to view the Turn List page.
- **3** Touch to view the Where Am I? page.
- Touch ⊕ and to zoom in and out.
- Touch to return to the Main menu.
- **6** Touch to change the data field.
- **7** Touch to view the Trip Computer.

Adding a Stop

- While navigating a route, touch
 > Where To?.
- 2. Search for the extra stop.
- 3. Touch Go!.
- Touch Add as Via Point to add this stop before your final destination.

Charging Your nüvi

Charge your nüvi for at least 4 hours before using on battery power.

- Connect the vehicle power cable.
- Connect the USB cable (optional accessory).
- Connect an AC adapter (optional accessory).

Securing Your nüvi

- Ensure that you are at your security location and that your nüvi is receiving satellite signals.
- Touch Tools > Settings > Security.
- Touch the button below Garmin Lock.
- 4. Enter a four-digit PIN.
- 5. Touch Set.



NOTE: If you forget your PIN and your security location, you must send your nüvi to Garmin to get it unlocked. You must also send a valid product registration or proof of purchase.
